

Statistics Show: Better Language Skills Equals A Better Lifestyle.

National Center for Education Statistics show risks and rewards (2003 statistics).

- 85% of all juveniles who interface with the juvenile court system are functionally illiterate
- 16 – 19 year-old girls at the poverty level and below, with below average reading skills, are 6 times more likely to have out-of-wedlock children than their reading counterparts
- Adults who have high-level reading skills make an 81% higher yearly salary than those that lacked basic skills

How do children learn?

Scientific research shows children learn vocabulary in two ways; Indirectly and Directly.

Children learn most words indirectly, through everyday experiences; talking, listening and reading. Reading aloud to your children, discussing books and subjects of interest and simply talking to them around the dinner table are all ways to help your them learn vocabulary indirectly.

Direct vocabulary learning refers to learning through specific teaching and instruction. Direct instruction helps children learn difficult words that are not commonly used in their everyday life. It also helps them understand and express complex concepts, gives them the language skills to read, listen and analyze difficult and broad subjects and helps them communicate their higher level thoughts in an effective way.
